We are dedicated to providing basic needs and warm clothing for homeless veterans and veterans in need.

HISTORY

Since 1994, there has been a grass-roots program in the Sanford Maine area to provide warm clothing and basic needs to veterans in need. This program has grown from items stored in a closet to what you see today. We are sanctioned and supported by the Department of Veterans Affairs, the State of Maine, Veteran Organizations and non-profit agencies State-wide.

JAGGER MILL, LLC

provides us this space for our use along with electricity, water, kitchen and bathroom facilities plus the use of their loading dock..

York County Shelters, Inc. graciously donated this facility to our Program for five years until January 2009.

Other contributions such as socks and underwear are donated by Rolling Thunder of Southern Maine and by the Biddeford American Legion Auxiliary. During the winter holiday season, both organizations also provide gifts of toys and clothes for veteran families in need.

Patco Construction, Deering Lumber, Home Depot and volunteer contributors have donated lumber and materials for our shelving and new outdoor steps.

Office supplies are donated by Vet Centers in New England and individual contributors.

Individuals donate coffee and snacks for our veteran visitors.

Our Program is successful thanks to the efforts, hard work and dedication of our volunteers.

ONGOING SERVICE

The results over the past twelve years have shown thousands of veterans being helped through this program. We now average supplying clothing and basic needs to over three hundred (300) veterans a month during the cold season (September through April).

In addition, we also supply warm military clothing and blankets to 21 non-profit organizations targeting veterans - including Sanford PD, Portland PD, Sanford Rescue, the York County Sheriff's Department, Biddeford PD and FD, State Police and Maine Warden Service. We also supply other vet centers in Maine, New Hampshire and Massachusetts, homeless shelters in Maine and New Hampshire and emergency service organizations with the emphasis on homeless veterans and veterans in need.
