

9th Annual Royal River Rod & Gun Club Ice Fishing Derby Saturday, February 5th, 2022 from 7:00 AM - 2:00 PM Lower Range Pond State Park, 26 State Park Rd, Poland, ME

Prizes will include:

- Powered Ice Auger (donated by Kittery Trading Post)
- Guided Open Water Fishing Trip for one child (less than 15 years old) and one adult (donated by Maine Guide Greg Massey)
- Set of five Heritage Laker Ice Fishing Traps (donated by the Royal River Rod & Gun Club)
- 50/50 raffle tickets will be available during the Derby for \$2.00 per ticket or \$5 for 3 tickets or \$10 for 7 tickets

Starting at 7:00 am, the first 15 children in line with a paid ticket will receive a free Heritage Laker Ice Fishing Trap (\$37 value)

- Tickets: \$15 per person. They are available at Mooney's Bait in New Gloucester, Dag's Bait and Tackle in Auburn, and during the Derby. Everyone with a ticket will not have to pay the day use fee at Lower Range Pond State Park.
- Rules: The Derby will start at 7:00 am. The Weigh-In will be in the parking lot near the boat launch at Lower Range Pond State Park. Cut off time is 2:00 pm sharp for the Derby Weigh-In and the 50/50 raffle drawing.
- The ice auger is a door prize. The winner will be chosen by a random drawing of one Derby ticket. You may purchase multiple Derby tickets as each will count as one chance at the auger. You do not need to be present to win the auger. The Guided Open Water Fishing Trip will be awarded to a lucky child (less than 15 years old) from a random drawing of all children with a paid ticket that are present at the Weigh-In.
- 1st pick of the Derby prizes goes to the lucky angler with the heaviest trout. If no trout are entered, 1st pick of
 prizes will go to the angler with the heaviest fish. 2nd pick goes to the angler with the next heaviest fish. Choice
 of remaining prizes will be awarded in this fashion (based on fish weight) until all prizes have been awarded. Any
 unclaimed prizes will be awarded by a random drawing of derby tickets.
- Only one fish may be entered per person. All fish must be caught from Lower Range Pond during the Derby.
 All Maine Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and Lower Range Pond State Park Rules and Regulations apply.
 All decisions of the Royal River Rod & Gun Club are final.
